### A SURPRISING DISCOVERY

If you were asked to name the best Mynderse Academy girls' basketball team, what year would come to mind? I'll bet the girls team of 1921-22 won't enter your thoughts. Why, that was seven years before the Great Depression! The "flats" section of Seneca Falls had recently been torn down to make room for the current NYS Cayuga-Seneca canal. A.H. Boyce Garage in Seneca Falls was selling fully equipped Chevrolets for \$525. And, you could buy Cuban cigars legally for \$2.25 a box. While doing research for the 1952, '53 & '54 Mynderse baseball teams (inducted into the MAA HOF last year), I learned that there was a girls basketball team from 1921-'22 that went undefeated, 17-0. The team was coached by my former Mynderse history teacher Billie (Battenfield) Oliver during her first year of teaching in Seneca Falls. The team of eight played in a different era. In the early 1900's, girl's teams were limited to a minimum of 6 and maximum of 9 players. The coach was not paid, in fact, the girls had to pay for their own uniforms, sneakers, balls, even court rental time. That's right, court rental time because the boys and girls played in the Lyceum in Seneca Falls. You haven't heard of the Lyceum - I hadn't either. It turns out it was located on the upper floor of the old Hunnington Garage near the Memorial Bridge. The '21-'22 team played using different rules with 3 girls on one half of the court – 3 forwards playing offense on one half and guards playing defense on the other half. The rules may have been different from today but the girls athleticism was every bit as developed as today's athletes. During their 17 game season, the girls not only played surrounding schools which included Ovid, Clyde, Phelps, Canandaigua, Waterloo, Penn Yan and Ithaca but industrial all star teams including the Kodak All Stars of Rochester and the Women's Educational & Industrial Union. Another big difference between today's game and '20's could be found in the score. It was normal to have very low scoring games for both the girls and boys teams. The 1921-'22 girl's team averaged 22.6 points per game while holding their opponents to a meager 8.4 points. In one notable game, the girls played Phelps on October 16, 1921 and held them scoreless, which was unusual in basketball for any time period. It didn't seem to matter whom this team played as they powered their way through that long ago season. The deep richness of Mynderse athletics continues to surprise me.

### Remembrance of Departed Members


It was less than a year ago the MAA HOF inducted members of the 1952,'53 & '54 baseball teams.

Two of those members inducted passed away this past year.


We will all miss Pete Saracino and Richard Yates.
